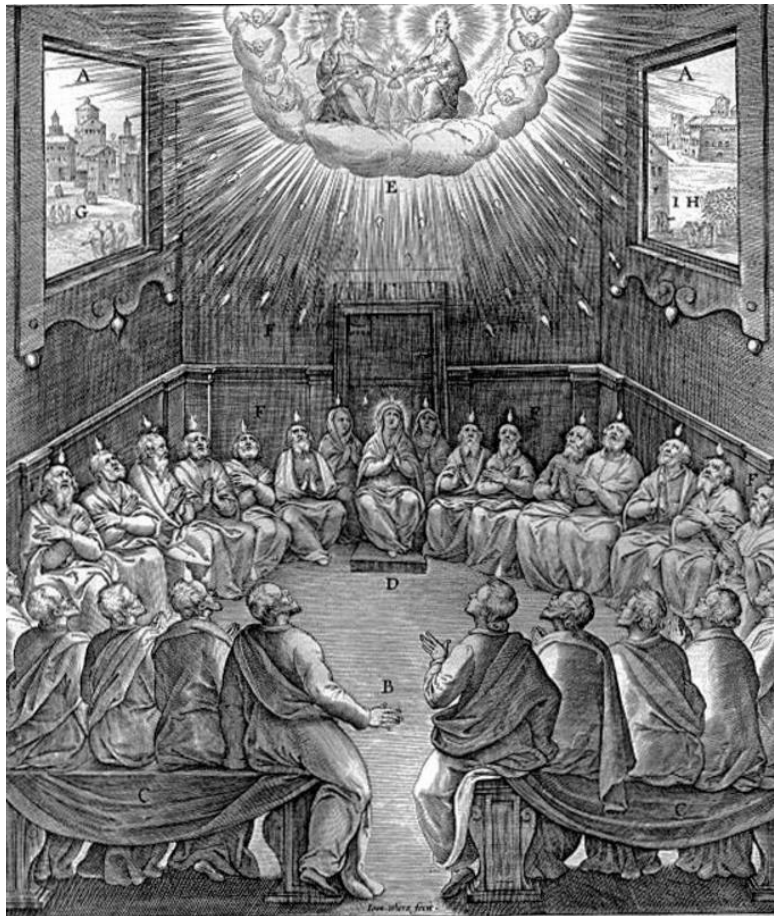


NOVENA PILGRIMAGE TO PENTECOST

May 26 to June 4, 2017



For the 100th year celebration of Our Lady of Fatima, The Knights of Columbus and Schola Cantus Angelorum invite you to a Novena Pilgrimage in preparation for Pentecost.

Journey with us through the beautiful and historic churches in the greater Salem and Portland areas as we ask the Holy Spirit to deeply renew our lives and our Church. In communion with Our Holy Mother Mary and the Apostles in the “Upper Room” we will pray a Novena of Masses awaiting Pentecost and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

Each day of the Pilgrimage will center on the Holy Mass to be celebrated in the different and historic and beautiful Churches of the diocese. The masses will be celebrated by priests serving in the Archdiocese and Archbishop Alexander Sample and Cantus Angelorum will chant the liturgical music.

Join us and experience the beauty of the liturgy during nine days of prayer and preparation for Pentecost. Open your hearts to a new life in the Holy Spirit and experience God’s superabundant grace.

Schedule:

Day One May 26 (Fri)	7:00 PM	Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit at St. Mary's in Mt. Angel celebrated by Fr. Philip Waibel, OSB. Lecture following Mass –Fr. Peter Arteaga MSPS- On the charism of the Missionaries of the Holy Spirit applied to daily life.
Day Two May 27 (Sat)	10:00 AM	Votive Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary at St. Boniface in Sublimity celebrated by Fr. Theodore Lange. Following Mass – a catechesis on The Holy Spirit and Creation. A walk in Silver Falls State Park to give thanks for the beauty of God's Creation.
Day Three May 28 (Sun)	12:00 PM	Ascension Sunday Mass at St. Joseph's in Salem celebrated by Fr. John Arcidiacono. Following Mass –a catechesis on the first Cenacle in Jerusalem.
Day Four May 29 (Mon)	2:00 PM	Requiem Mass for Memorial Day at the Cathedral celebrated by the Most Reverend Archbishop Alexander Sample. Following Mass – a procession through Calvary cemetery reciting the Litany of the Holy Spirit, the rosary, and prayers for the Poor Souls of the diocese.
Day Five May 30 (Tue)	7:00 PM	Votive Mass for the Angels at St. Patrick's in Portland celebrated by Fr. Lucas Laborde. Following Mass –a lecture by the Society of St. John on the Holy Spirit in our lives.
Day Six May 31 (Wed)	7:00 PM	Mass of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary at Our Lady of Lavang in Portland celebrated by Fr. Theodore Lange. Following Mass – a procession in the gardens honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary.
Day Seven June 1 (Thu)	7:00 PM	Mass of Holy Spirit at St. Thomas More celebrated by Fr. Martin L. King Following Mass – a catechesis on the Holy Spirit in the life of Thomas Moore.
Day Eight June 2 (Fri)	7:00 PM	Votive Mass of the Sacred Heart at St. Paul, in St. Paul celebrated by Monsignor Gregory Moys. Following Mass – a lecture by Msgr. Moys on St. Paul as the first Catholic church in the Archdiocese and the beginnings of the Archdiocese.
Day Nine June 3 (Sat)	5:30 PM	Vespers with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at Brigittine Priory of Our Lady of Consolation in Amity Vigil Mass of Pentecost celebrated by Fr. Theodore Lange. Following Mass – adoration until midnight. Prayer and catechesis on the Holy Spirit.
June 4 (Sun) 12:00PM	10:00 AM	Catechesis on the Holy Spirit – Fr. Theodore Lange Pentecost Sunday Mass at Brigittine Priory of Our Lady of Consolation in Amity celebrated by Fr. Theodore Lange. Following Mass – Eucharistic Procession and lunch with the Brigittine monks.

Cost of the Pilgrimage: \$25.00 payable to The Brigittine monks. For those wanting overnight accommodation at the Brigittine Priory, the cost is \$45 per night.

The cost of honorarium for the priests and the use of each of the pilgrimage churches will be paid for by freewill offerings at each Mass.
