

THE INTERNATIONAL PILGRIM VIRGIN STATUE OF FATIMA IS COMING TO OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP!

**Join us for an afternoon of Prayer and veneration
of the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima
at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Cottage Grove, Oregon**



The world-famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima is recognized as the primary way in which the message of Fatima has spread throughout the world and continues to do today.

Sculpted by Jose Thedim—"the Michelangelo of Portugal"—the statue has been traveling internationally since 1947.

On October 13, 1947, in the presence of 200,000 pilgrims at Fatima, the statue was blessed by the Bishop of Lieria-Fatima and commissioned to serve as the Pilgrim Virgin.

The bishop prayed that Mary herself accompany the statue wherever it goes.

She was then flown to America, where she was crowned in Ottawa, Canada, and began a 2-year tour of Canada and the U.S.

She has since traveled to over 100 countries, claiming her dominion and carrying Fatima's blessings and urgent message to people worldwide.

- 4:30pm Welcome of the statue with hymn.
- 4:40pm Talk on Fatima and the significance of this statue.
- 5:00pm Vespers
- 5:30pm Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- 5:40pm Recitation of the Rosary with Litany of Loreto
- 6:00pm Consecrations to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary
- 6:15pm Silent adoration of the Eucharist and private/individual prayers to Our Lady. Confessions.
- 7:15pm Divine Mercy chaplet followed by continuing silent adoration.
- 8:00pm Benediction
- 8:15pm Blessing and imposition of scapulars and conclusion with hymn.
- 8:30pm End.
