St. Alice is honored to host a visit of the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima (IPVS), which, sculpted in 1947 according to visionary Lucia's instructions, was blessed by the Bishop of Fatima and sent out to bring the graces of Fatima and Our Lady's message to the world. The statue depicts Our Lady's appearance when she revealed herself as the Immaculate Heart to the three children in Fatima in 1917.
