

FATIMA STATUE COMING TO OUR PARISH



The world-famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue, which has been traveling for over 75 years, will be at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Eugene on Saturday, May 4th and Sunday, May 5th 2024.

After being blessed by the Bishop of Leiria-Fatima, on October 13, 1947, the statue left Fatima and was flown to America to begin its tours. The bishop prayed that Our Lady's presence would travel with it wherever she went. It was blessed again in 1952 by Pope Pius XII, who crowned the original statue in Fatima as Queen of the World a few years earlier. The International Pilgrim Virgin Statue has visited more than 100 countries, including Russia and China, bringing Mary's powerful message of salvation and hope to millions of people.
